Thank you for contacting me about United States policy on torture. I appreciate hearing from you on this particular piece of legislation.

As you may know, S. 147, the Lawful Interrogation and Detention Act, which would limit the use of certain interrogation techniques, among other things. It was introduced in the Senate on January 6, 2009, and referred to the Select Committee on Intelligence. I will keep your comment in mind as this or related legislation come before the full Senate for consideration.
