## IS CHRISTIAN EDUCATION A COMMAND OR A SUGGESTION?

Prov. 19:27, *“Cease, my son, to hear the instruction that causeth to err from the words of knowledge.”*

The teacher is just as important as the textbook. A child spends over 15,000 hours in the classroom from K-12, and just 2,000 hours in church. What has the greatest influence, the school or the church? Do you think the church can wash away the teachings of the world in just one or two hours a week compared to eight hours a day in a worldly environment? Don't fool yourself. The Bible says in Rom. 16:19, "... I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil."

Secular textbooks are inappropriate for Christian children. Secular publishers are more concerned about being politically correct than historically and scientifically accurate. Publishers are pressured to portray feminists, homosexuals, and Muslims in a positive light. For example, to satisfy the feminists, they do not use words like "manpower", "chairman", "forefathers", "freshman", "businessman", and "mankind". The secular textbook no longer has literary merit. Notice Psalm 1:1, 2, *“Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the Lord; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.”*

We need textbooks that are free from political and philosophical influences that contradict the TRUTH of the Bible or historical facts. There are four major textbook publishers, and only one is American.

They are British, French, British-Dutch. It is no wonder that American textbooks are not sympathetic with the American values, history, or faith.

Parents should be seriously concerned about the alternative lifestyle education taught in the schools. They should be aware of the evolutionism-based textbooks, the increase of drugs, immorality, and violence in public schools. Parents need to be conscious of the teaching of sex education, easy access to birth control pills, abortion, and the poor student achievement in the U.S.

Paul warned believers in Col. 2:8, *“Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.”*

It is a privilege and blessing to have a Christian school with qualified, born-again teachers, and a curriculum and philosophy based on the Word of God – I Sam. 16:18, *“Then answered one of the servants, and said, Behold, I have seen a son of Jesse the Bethlehemite, that is cunning in playing, and a mighty valiant man, and a man of war, and prudent in matters, and a comely person, and the Lord is with him.”*
